Honor Unit with Distinction Insignia. Each member of a unit designated as an Honor Unit with Distinction is awarded the Honor Unit with Distinction Insignia (yellow star).

Honor Unit Insignia. Each member of a unit designated as an Honor Unit is awarded the Honor Unit Insignia (blue star).

Meritorious Unit Insignia. Each member of a unit designated as an Meritorious Unit is awarded the Meritorious Unit Insignia (white star).



Academic Achievement Insignia. A gold wreath authorized for wear by cadets in the top ten percent of each JROTC class - based on grades earned in JROTC courses, as determined by the SAI. Subsequent awards are indicated by a felt pad center background.

• Second award – red pad. • Third award – silver pad. • Fourth award – gold pad.


